

# Fighting your cancer in the liver

If you or a relative have recently received the news about liver cancer, whether primary or secondary cancer, it can be a deeply upsetting time for you and your family.

## What is Chemosaturation?

Chemosaturation Therapy or CHEMOSAT® is a new method of treating cancers in the liver. The concept of CHEMOSAT® is to temporarily isolate the liver from the body's blood circulation and deliver concentrated doses of an anti-cancer drug directly to the liver, "saturating" the entire organ.

Blood leaving the liver is directed outside of the body to filters that remove most of the anti-cancer drug before returning it to the body. By delivering this drug to the entire liver, treatment is administered to potentially both visible tumours and undetected micro tumours.

## How can I find out if I am eligible for CHEMOSAT® treatment?

CHEMOSAT® may be suitable for patients who have liver tumours where either the liver is the only site of disease or the liver is the major site of disease e.g. it may be suitable for patients who have colon cancer which has metastasised to the liver.

CHEMOSAT® can potentially treat:

- **Primary liver cancer:** cancer that starts in your liver
- **Secondary/Metastatic liver cancer:** cancer that starts in a different part of your body and then spreads to the liver

Talk to your doctor to find out if you are eligible for this treatment.

## Questions to ask your doctor:

- What tests will I need to have done prior to receiving CHEMOSAT®?
- How is CHEMOSAT® different from standard chemotherapy?
- What is the clinical benefit of CHEMOSAT®?
- How long does the procedure take?
- Where can I get the procedure done and how much will it cost?
